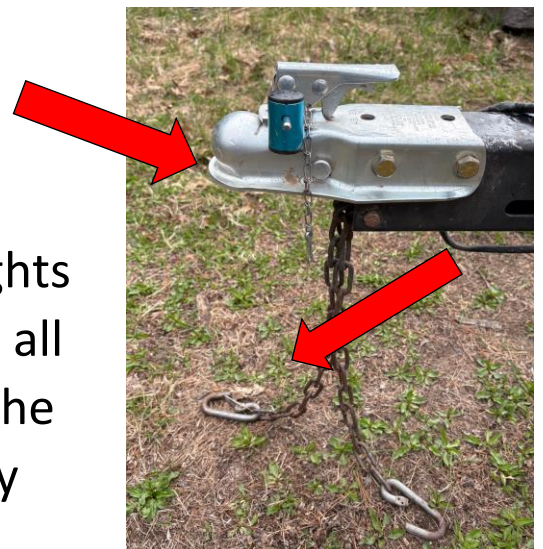


IMLPOA PONTOON TRAILER

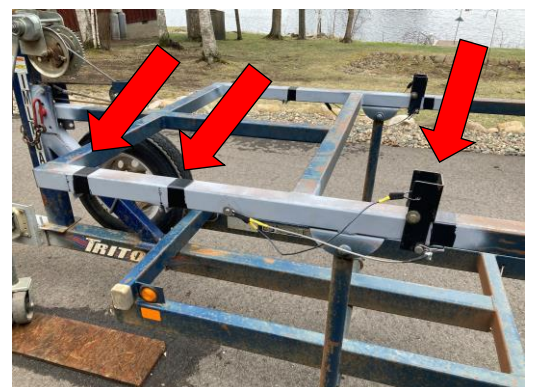
USAGE GUIDELINES - MUST READ

1. Your membership dues provide you free use of the trailer, only members with reservations are to use the trailer.
2. The Island and Mud Lake Property Owners Association provide this trailer for members to use on Island/Mud Lakes only. Do **NOT** use this trailer on any other body of water in order to prevent the transport of invasive species to Island/Mud Lakes.
3. Use this trailer **AT YOUR OWN RISK**. The Association is **NOT** responsible for any accidents, damage, improper towing, injuries, or damage caused by its use. **YOU** are responsible for any damage to the trailer and will be required to pay for any repairs due to accidents or misuse

4. **Verify** you have completed all of the following: Don't loosen any hitch fittings, the ball latch is closed, and safety pin (lock) is inserted, unplug lights before entering the water, check that all wiring is secure and not dragging on the roadway, all safety chains are securely attached to your vehicle.



5. Be sure to have the pontoon loaded all the way forward on the trailer. There are 3 adjustable stops to accommodate 20-foot, 22-foot, and longer pontoons. Adjust the stops to fit your pontoon and load as far forward as possible and yet avoid the rear transom.



6. Always strap the pontoon to the welded chain links on the bottom rail at the front and rear of the trailer, crisscross the straps, to prevent it from shifting left or right or from sliding forward / backward.



7. Limit the time that the wheels and lights are in the water to prevent water collecting in the bearings and lights.

8. Always be sure the bed is secured in the upper-most position with the pin provided when moving a pontoon. **DO NOT** use the trailer without the pin in place because that would cause the strain/load to be entirely on the cable.



9. Please be courteous to your fellow members and use the trailer efficiently to minimize your time and make the trailer available for others to use, please return the trailer in the timeline you made your reservation.

10. Be sure to follow all laws/regulations pertaining to trailer towing. While it is trailered, **DO NOT** allow anyone to ride on the pontoon. **DO NOT** tow a pontoon with any vehicle (ATV, etc.) that is not rated to tow the loaded trailer's weight.

11. Report any issues when you return the trailer.

12. The trailer is stored on private property, please do not wander around the property, OR disturb anything.
